Torino Short Film Market vol.6

Welcome to Torino Short Film Market (TSFM) vol. 6, our sixth edition and our first fully hybrid event. Following the online only vol. 5, the whole team worked all year round to bring TSFM back to Torino without forgetting the positive extents that an online event can deliver in terms of attraction, outreach and openness to the world.

Since its first edition, TSFM has found its peculiarity in linking different markets, industries and businesses that usually are not in connection with each other. TSFM vol. 6 continues this tradition. European distributors, producers, and international buyers of short films are gathered together by the Distributors Meet Buyers, Short Comedies, You Only Pitch Twice and TSFM Word-Frame pitches. Moreover, producers and broadcasters of feature films and television series attend the Oltrecorto pitching session and leading players in the digital and extended reality field are present in order to follow the XR Stories pitching session.

Attending professionals will also find new opportunities to increase their expertise by attending several panels and a keynote focusing on various topics such as: animated shorts, audience development, awards, DIY distribution, European co-productions, pitching opportunities, short film narratives and XR funding. Furthermore, they will be able to learn more about the Swedish short film industry in our Country in Focus session.

TSFM vol. 6 marks the beginning of a new fundamental strain for the market: talent development. This year, the launch of TSFM Word-Frame is the first step in that direction. TSFM Word-Frame is an intensive international training on short film writing and production for short film directors and screenwriters, running throughout the year across several workshops taking place in Italy and Europe.

This edition also sees the expansion to a new location as the principal main venue of the on-site event, the grandiose Museo del Risorgimento, shared in the days before with other activities related to Torino Film Industry. Once again, Il Circolo dei Lettori e Palazzo Cisterna will host specific TSFM vol. 6 events, as well as for the first time the Museo del Cinema.

Finally, all the accredited guests — both those who will attend the on-site event and those who will join only online — will have the possibility to meet other professionals and follow or relive our events on our online platform at online.torinofilmindustry.it from November 29th to December 10th and to watch films in our curated online Video-Library and Market Screenings.

TSFM vol. 6 is a hybrid event.

Accredited professionals can both attend the on-site event in Torino from December 1st to December 3rd and the online extent from November 29th to December 10th.

All main events of the on-site branch will take place at Museo del Risorgimento (Piazza Carlo Alberto 8, Torino), except for the keynote presentation which will take place at Palazzo Cisterna (Via Maria Vittoria 12, Torino), TSFM Word-Frame Workshop which will be located at Il Circolo dei Lettori (Via Giambattista Bogino 9, Torino) and the XR Content corner which can be found at Museo del Cinema (Via Montebello 20, Torino).

Online

The online extent is reachable at online.torinofilmindustry.it by clicking on the FilmChief icon and logging with the username and password used during the accreditation process.

The pitching sessions, panels, country in focus and closing ceremonies are streamed live on the platform and available on demand immediately after the live events. Except for the keynote, which will be made available on the platform to be watched on demand from December 6th 2021.



Covid-19 Regulations

Access to the venues is regulated by the Covid-19 health safety regulations valid at the moment of entry. A valid EU Digital Covid Certificate is mandatory to be admitted and it will be checked at the points of entry.

Accredited professionals not in possession of a valid EU Digital Covid Certificate can retrieve one by testing negative for Covid-19 in any recognised testing facility or hospital in Turin. Please note that PCR tests are not available at the pharmacy in Turin. The validity period for PCR tests is 72 hours, for antigen rapid tests it's 48 hours. Self-tests are not accepted.

Short Film Audiences: Where and How To Find Them

This keynote session will present the successful audience development related practices for short films that have been adopted in Germany over the course of more than twenty years. Subsequently, this presentation aims to kickstart a discussion on how to translate said practices in other European countries and cultural contexts, especially within the Italian landscape, with the opportunity of benefiting from European funding schemes.

The keynote will tackle this issue from different perspectives, resonating on various concepts, schemes and models of audience development in the field of short film: public television, festivals, distribution and promotional tools. Several aspects such as gender balance, inclusion, diversity and representativeness in audience development strategies will also be handled with concrete examples.

The first part will feature four keynote presentations focusing on four main aspects: (1) short films in German public television, with a special focus on the ARTE channel, (2) the German short film festival landscape, with a special focus on the activities of FILMFEST DRESDEN, (3) short films presence in German cinemas and (4) raising awareness on short films and reaching out to new audience outside the short film bubble through a case study on the Short Film Day in Germany.

The second part will consist of a moderated discussion between the four keynote speakers and corresponding Italian professionals as respondents, in order to develop a constructive discourse on the differences and similarities of the implemented audience development strategies for short films. The attending audience will also be able to ask questions.

In between the first and second part of the keynote, Silvia Sandrone of CED Italy MEDIA Torino will give a short presentation on the MEDIA Audience Development Call.



Now going into its twentieth edition, Magma – Mostra Di Cinema Breve has so far screened over nine thousand short films coming from ninety-five different countries, reaching a total attendance of about 17 300 festival goers and standing out as one of the best short film festivals in Italy. In contrast to bigger Italian film festivals, Magma has always focused on the short film format, considering it as a separate art form, as a format allowing the experimentation of new styles and the creation of new trends, the presentation of works from both first-time directors and established filmmakers.




