Welcoming Adresses

The Italian Short Film Center is launching a strategic plan in 2024 that will end in 2027, coinciding with two key anniversaries: the 65th anniversary of the AIACE Association's foundation and the 20th anniversary of the Center's launch.

The goal is to enhance the Center's long-standing objectives since its establishment in 2007: promoting national short films internationally, archiving and preserving short films, encouraging analysis and research, expanding knowledge of resources and opportunities, and hosting market events. To achieve these goals, the Center serves the entire short film industry and remains attentive to all its stakeholders on a continuous basis.

Due to these targets, also the market event's name has been changed. ShorTO Film Market is the new name for Talents and Short Film Market. It pertains to the short film, the main character in every function of the Center. It is talking about Turin, where the event was born, thrived, and developed for 9 years. It upholds the market's significance as a hub that enables networking, fosters talent exploration, facilitates work development, and facilitates global connections. It is a creative incubator for audiovisual content aimed at young people, be they creators, producers, distributors, festival programmers, cultural operators, etc.

ShorTO Film Market 2024 will carry on previous collaborations and initiatives while introducing new ones that focus on better integration among the different action areas of the Italian Short Film Center.

Starting from this year's edition, ShorTO will focus particularly on Italian creators and professionals, promoting professional mobility abroad and serving as a tool for educational and career growth beyond the annual November event.

The ISFVL Italian Short Films Video Library, established by the Italian Short Film Center to showcase and promote the best Italian short films, will be relaunched and available to all short film professionals.

The 2024 programme consists of two days of pitches for selected projects from the Italian and international circuits, followed by one-to-one meetings. One of these initiatives is the pilot program *Road to Euro Connection/Italy*, created in partnership with the Festival du court métrage de Clermont-Ferrand, which aims to become an annual event to facilitate the international mobility of young audiovisual professionals from Italy. ShorTO program will also feature a panel focusing on an in-depth analysis of XR projects with two international artists; a round table discussion on the current status of short films in Italy with key players in the sector; a meeting for aspiring filmmakers to take their first steps in filmmaking; a special screening and XR immersive rooms.







SYNOPSIS

Normcore guy Lukas is an industrial crane operator spending his days lifting marine containers at the port. During an intro briefing to a newcomer the realisation of his own sense of stagnation hits him leading to an ineffective escapist behaviour. Lukas is now eager to move but he does not know neither where exactly nor how. In such restless state a surreal encounter with a childhood self sparks attempt to save his newborn daughter from inheriting his own stuckness. Lukas' story is juxtaposed with TV archives from Suez canal blockage creating a metaphor for an enigmatic moment of universal existential crisis. News coverage of the colossal accident causing global disorder serves as a backdrop for Lukas' intimate struggle to navigate inner chaos.







Now, he must race against time to avoid freezing to death. As primal fear turns to madness, he envies his dog's natural protection. Lighting a fire becomes his only hope for survival.

Eleonora Muzzi graduated in Cinema from the University of Bologna. After gaining several years of experience in festival organization and programming with the Cineteca di Bologna, she completed a master's program that led her to join Sayonara Film in 2021 as an Assistant Producer and Sales Representative for their short film catalog. At Sayonara Film, Eleonora worked on the animated short "In una Goccia" by Valeria Weerasinghe and served as a production assistant for the short film "Chello 'ncuollo" by Olga Torrico. She is currently supervising the production of "Il Velo dei Sensi" by Elisa Baccolo and the development of "To Build a Fire" by Lorenzo Puntoni.

Adam Selo is a director and producer, based in Bologna. In 2004 he founded his independent production company, Elenfant Film. His work of producing and directing his first short films, and then distributing them in the festival circuit, led him to the founding of Elenfant Distribution, a distribution team that deals with national and international distribution and sale of short films. In 2016 he founded with Olga Torrico the production company Sayonara Film Srl. With Sayonara, he produced the documentaries After the Bridge by Rizzo and Toscano presented in Hot Docs and Casablanca by Valerio presented at Venice Film Festival, as well as the short films Gas Station and Impure by Torrico finalist to David di Donatello and Nastri d'Argento.



Between magical realism and documentary, a small rural story unfolds: children who carry the experiences of past generations explore the fields and forests of their village; a dog isolates itself in the vegetation, hunting a nonexistent prey; and a forest, a silent witness to the figures who inhabit it, holds within the changing seasons the threads of these glances.

PRODUCER'S BIO

A psychologist and biologist by training, Chiara Castiglioni lived in Mexico City and Chiapas, where she studied the behaviour of wild primates in the jungle and worked with local communities to promote biodiversity conservation. Since 2020 she has been working as a junior producer at Majmun Films in Berlin. Her passion for science, history and documentary filmmaking, combined with her international experience, multidisciplinary skills and project management abilities, make her a talented and versatile producer at Zero Stress. 

Will present itself as an immersive documentary that will use virtual reality as an empathetic interface immersing the viewer in the skin of a fish, from its life as a wild animal to its destiny as a consumer product, through all phases of its conditioning, then his disappearance. Without commentary or interview, this immersive device will offer an extreme, almost hypnotic experience, which will invite you to an introspective and meditative journey.

He will give the viewer the impression of navigating through the image as if he were a prisoner of the eye of the fish, unable to act other than by changing his point of view. Emotions and senses will be vectors of a visceral understanding of the animal condition. The Fisheye movie will present a hallucinated look at fishing, which is one of mankind's oldest activities. However, it will also deploy a portrait of the sea and human food circuits. The camera will witness the unique interaction between man, water, fish and machines. VR technology, thanks to its ability to arouse empathy, can then become a tool for rethinking our way of being in the world, our relationship to nature and therefore our living economy. When do we humans decide that an animal subject becomes an object, a consumer good? Can the technologies that are the fruit of the Anthropocene allow us to get out of anthropocentrism? To carry out this work, I will have to immerse myself in depth in the Italian food circuits, a country in which the sea and fishing are at the heart of culture and food.

Boris Labbé

ARTIST'S BIO

Trained at the École supérieure d'art de Tarbes and then at the École de cinéma d'animation d'Angoulême, the work of Boris Labbé (1987, FR) quickly toured the world, whether in contemporary art exhibitions, international film festivals, or during audiovisual concerts. His latest short film The Fall was selected for the Special Screening at the Critics' Week of the 2018 Cannes Film Festival. In 2020 he collaborated with the choreographer Angelin Preljocaj and signed the video scenography of the show Swan Lake. His films and video installations have earned him some fifty awards and distinctions around the world, including the Golden Nica Animation at the Ars Electronica Festival in Linz and the Grand Prix at the Japan Media Arts Festival in Tokyo. Between 2023 and 2024, he is developing and carrying out two landmark projects: Ito Meikyū, his first virtual reality project (produced by Sacrebleu Productions) and Glass House, a video scenography in collaboration with composer Lucas Fagin (produced by the Ensemble Cairn). Ito Meikyū has just been awarded the Grand Prix at the 2024 Venice Film Festival.
